

## Initial 2017 Results

### 1. Foundation Stage (EYFS):

85% of children achieved a Good Level of Development (GLD). The national average was 71%.

**Summary:** Our children are achieving significantly above national average.

### 2. Year 1 Phonics Screening:

77% of children achieved the expected standard. The national average was 81%.

**Summary:** Although we are 4% below average, this was a low attaining group at the end of Foundation Stage with 60% of children achieving GLD.

**Summary:** We are very happy with how well the children did. We were above LA for Reading in Met + and GD. In Writing we were significantly above LA for Met + and GD. In Mathematics we were significantly above LA for Met + and GD. Children have improved from 2016 results.

**Summary:** We were again very pleased with these results. In all but GD in Reading we were above national and LA results, with most of these being significantly above (green). We were especially pleased with how well our children did in Mathematics, which was a particular focus last year. One area for development this year is GD in Reading and Writing and especially boys Writing.
